NEW DESIGN HOTEL NEAR LUXEMBOURG GARDENS

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Just a stone's throw from chic Saint Germain des Pres and right next to the Luxembourg Gardens, there's a new luxury design hotel on the oldest street of Paris. The Hotel Le Petit Paris takes its inspiration from history and glamour. And each one of the 20 luxuriously decorated rooms takes you back in time through the history of the hotel. Five themes are represented: Medieval, Louis XV, Napoleon III, the roaring twenties, and the 70s (Jim Morrison stayed here).



The designer, Sybille de Margerie (whose past decorating ventures include the Hotel de Crillon) spared no expense. From silk drapery to mosaic tiles with embedded lighting in the bathrooms, each room highlights the finer things in life and no detail is overlooked. And if you are looking for a place to accommodate a family or group of six, there is even a family suite available; which is a rare find in Paris.
